<u>GLEN ROCK</u> — Smokers, take note: Avoid <u>Glen Rock</u>'s parks if you want to light up.

Add <u>Glen Rock</u> to the growing list of <u>Bergen County</u> communities that have banned smoking in public parks in recent months.

The ban, approved unanimously by the Borough Council last week, establishes smoke-free areas around parks, fields and playgrounds.

Other facilities, including the borough pool, are also now smoke-free zones under the ordinance.

Signs detailing the ban will be displayed in all affected areas.

Those failing to abide by the new mandate face a \$1,000 fine or 90 days of community service.
